RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BURLINGTON, DES MOINES COUNTY, IOWA EXTENDING AN INVITATION TO THE CITY OF BARBACENA, BRAZIL, SOUTH AMERICA, TO BECOME A SISTER-CITY IN THE PEOPLE-TO-PEOPLE PROGRAM AND INVITING THE PEOPLE OF BARBACENA TO PARTICIPATE IN SAID PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the continents of South America and North America are indissolubly linked together by reason of common interests, and

WHEREAS, those interests include a love of liberty and a deep and abiding consideration for the welfare of mankind everywhere, and

WHEREAS, the people of the United States of America yield to no one in their admiration of the people of South America, and

WHEREAS, the people of Burlington, Iowa, desire to give expression to their admiration and friendship for the people of South America in general and the people of Barbacena, Brazil, in particular.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Burlington, Iowa, United States of America, on this thirty-first day of May in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-three, in its City Council meeting, express its desire that the City of Barbacena, Brazil, become its "Sister City," thus cementing the bonds of friendship of the two communities and contributing to the understanding of their respective countries.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That copies of this Resolution are to be sent to Mayor Jose Eugenio Dutra Camara of the City of Barbacena, Brazil, the American Municipal Association, the United States Department of State and the Embassy of Brazil, South America.
