ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SISTER CITIES RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK, NEW JERSEY, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE CITY OF DEBRECEN IN HUNGARY:


The CITY of NEW BRUNSWICK, NEW JERSEY, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA and the CITY of DEBRECEN in HUNGARY, agree to formally establish a Sister City relationship to further promote mutual understanding and friendship between people of the two cities and countries.

NEW BRUNSWICK and DEBRECEN agree to carry out, on the basis of this friendly relationship and in accordance with the principles of equality and mutual benefit, from time to time, exchanges and cooperative efforts in such fields as culture and arts, education, economics and trade, science and technology, tourism, health care, sports, urban development and city management and other; and to encourage prosperity and development between the two cities.


The two cities agree to keep in contact in a proper manner and to discuss in detail the benefits and needs of exchanges and cooperative efforts between the two cities before any activity takes place.

This agreement comes into effect on the date when it is signed by the two Mayors of the two cities.

This agreement is signed in the CITY of NEW BRUNSWICK on MAY 18, 1990 and is prepared in duplicate in the Hungarian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.
